Accessing the Pen Tool

- 1. Open CoreIDRAW and create a new document.
- 2. Select the **Pen Tool** from the toolbox on the left side of the interface.
 - Shortcut: Press **P** to activate the Pen Tool.

Basic Usage

- 1. Drawing Straight Lines:
 - Click to place a node (point) on the canvas.
 - Click again to create a straight line segment between the nodes.
